¹ Claimant’s objection to the Report and Recommendation provided additional information in that it listed the names and addresses, in South Florida, of eleven witnesses whom it claims would be necessary to prove an innocent owner defense. However, the objection does not contain any details of those proposed witnesses’ testimony which would allow the court to evaluate the significance of the potential testimony or whether any given witness’s testimony might be duplicitous. Accordingly, the court finds that the assertion adds little to the information previously provided.
