**JUDGMENT**

In accordance with the order entered on this date, it is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** that the Commissioner’s unopposed motion to remand (Doc. 17) is hereby **GRANTED**, and **JUDGMENT** is entered reversing the Commissioner’s decision.
