ORDER

After due and proper consideration of the issues raised, and there having been no objections filed, the Report and Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge made under 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and dated June 19, 2015, is **ADOPTED** as the opinion of this Court.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that Plaintiff's Motion to Remand (Doc. 7) is **DENIED**, Defendant USA's Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 3) is **GRANTED**, and Plaintiff's Motion to Remand (Doc. 17) is **GRANTED**, such that this action is hereby **REMANDED** to the Circuit Court of Wilcox County, Alabama from whence it came.¹

It is further **ORDERED** that the claims against Defendants Champion and the United States of America are **DISMISSED** and that said defendants are **DISMISSED** from this action.
