15 Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's Application for Order to Show Cause Why
16 Injunction Should Not Issue to Enforce Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 42
17 U.S.C. § 1973c and Request to Convene Three-Judge Court (Doc. # 2). To the extent
18 Plaintiff requests that a three-judge court be convened, the Court finds that the Section 5
19 challenge is not "wholly insubstantial." See *Goosby v. Osser*, 409 U.S. 512, 518 (1973).
20 Therefore,

21 **IT IS ORDERED** that a three-judge court shall be convened to hear Plaintiff's
22 Application for Order to Show Cause Why Injunction Should Not Issue to Enforce Section
23 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C. § 1973c.


