4           **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the last day for Plaintiff to file a motion for  
5 summary judgment is extended to **January 16, 2009.**

6           **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that all other provisions in the Scheduling Order  
7 dated April 8, 2008 (Dkt. 4) shall remain in effect.
