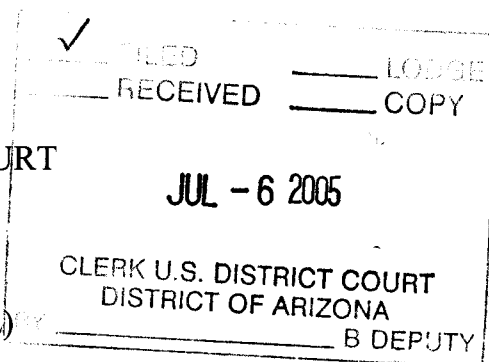



As to each motion which the non-movant does not oppose, the non-movant's timely Response must so state.

If the parties seek from the District Court a continuance of the trial date, the parties must notify the Magistrate Judge of same.

This matter is set for trial on August 16, 2005 at 9:30 a.m. before the Honorable John M. Roll.
