




1 Court will accept the R&R and deny the Petition and dismiss the Petition with prejudice. *See*  
2 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) (stating that the district court “may accept, reject, or modify, in whole  
3 or in part, the findings or recommendations made by the magistrate”); Fed. R. Civ. P.  
4 72(b)(3) (“The district judge may accept, reject, or modify the recommended disposition;  
5 receive further evidence; or return the matter to the magistrate judge with instructions.”).

6 **IT IS ORDERED:**

- 7 1. Magistrate Judge Edward C. Voss’s R&R (Dkt. #18) is **accepted**.  
8 2. Petitioner Jose Alfred Perez-Valenzuela’s petition for writ of habeas corpus  
9 (Dkt. #1) is **denied and dismissed with prejudice**.  
10 3. The Clerk of Court shall **terminate** this action.
