14	Pursuant to motion by the government (Dkt. #25), and without objection by defense
15	counsel,
16	IT IS ORDERED that the government's motion (Dkt. #25) is granted. The
17	evidentiary hearing set for February 23, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. is VACATED and RESET to
18	April 20, 2010 at 1:00 p.m. The Court will set aside three hours for the hearing, although
19	it is likely to take less time. As the question to be addressed is the nature of the discussions
20	between Eljammal and his counsel, William Foreman, on the pre-conviction plea
21	negotiations, the government should be prepared to call Mr. Foreman to testify and to present
22	other evidence in support of its position, and counsel for Mr. Eljammal should be prepared
23	to call Mr. Eljammal to testify and to present other evidence in support of his position. If
24	counsel have questions or concerns about the hearing, they should place a joint conference
25	call to the Court.
