Upon motion of the defendant, the government not objecting, and good cause appearing therefore,

This court specifically finds that the ends of justice served by taking this action outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial. This finding is based on the court's conclusion that the failure to grant such a continuance would unreasonably deny the defendant continuity of counsel and would deny the attorney for the defendant the reasonable time necessary for effective preparation, taking into account the exercise of due diligence. 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(8)(b)(IV).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED continuing the trial from May 1, 2007 to June 5, 2007 at 9:00 a.m., pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(8)(A).


