Complaint for violation of Title 21 United States Code § 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A)(ii)(II)

COMPLAINANT'S STATEMENT OF FACTS CONSTITUTING THE OFFENSE OR VIOLATION:

On or about April 15, 2007, at or near Nogales, in the District of Arizona, **Yara Patricia Cota-Gonzalez**, did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute 5 kilograms or more of cocaine, that is, approximately 11.04 kilograms of cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A)(ii)(II).

BASIS OF COMPLAINANT'S CHARGE AGAINST THE ACCUSED:

On April 15, 2007, at approximately 9:30 p.m., **Yara Patricia Cota-Gonzalez** entered the United States from the Republic of Mexico via the Deconcini Port of Entry in Nogales, Arizona. A search of **Cota-Gonzalez's** vehicle revealed approximately 11.04 kilograms of cocaine hidden in the floorboard of the car. After being interviewed, **Cota-Gonzalez** admitted that she was going to deliver the vehicle to the McDonald's restaurant at Irvington Road and Interstate 19 in Tucson, Arizona. **Cota-Gonzalez** admitted that she knew the car contained contraband, but she stated she did not know what type of contraband. She stated she was going to be paid but she didn't know how much.


