

16 **THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:**

17 On or about May 9, 2007, at or near the Village of Chuichu, in the District of Arizona,
18 on the Tohono O'odham Indian Nation, **Baltzar Bernal-Olaiz**, did intentionally and forcibly
19 assault, resist, oppose, impede, intimidate and interfere with United States Customs and
20 Border Protection Officer Jason Wardlow, an officer of the United States, Department of
21 Homeland Security, while said officer was engaged in and on account of the performance of
22 his official duties, that is, **Baltazar Bernal-Olaiz** punched Officer Wardlow in the abdomen


