

Court refers the matter to Magistrate Judge (Jurio to administer the allocution pursuant to Rule 11, F.R.Crim.P., and to make findings as follows:

- (A) whether defendant (1) is competent to enter a plea; knowingly and voluntarily wishes to enter a plea to the charge(s); understands the charge(s); (4) whether there exists a factual basis for the charges; and a recommendation as follows:
- whether the plea of guilty should be accepted by the District Court.

The Magistrate Judge is requested to use the allocution drafted and used by the Court in taking a guilty plea.
