COUNT I

That on or about February 28, 2007, Defendant Juvenal Gonzalez, an alien, entered or attempted to enter the United States, and on or about May 10, 2007 was found in the United States at or near Lake Havasu, Arizona within the District of Arizona, after having been previously denied admission, excluded, deported, or removed from the United States to Mexico through the port of San Luis, Arizona on or about April 22, 2007. The Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security not theretofore having consented to any reapplication by the Defendant for admission into the United States, in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a), enhanced by (b)(1) (Felony).



6 **STATEMENT OF FACTUAL BASIS**

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8 The complainant states that this complaint is based upon the statements of the
9 apprehending officers, that the Defendant was found and arrested on or about May 10, 2007,
10 near Lake Havasu, Arizona. Questioning of the Defendant by agents revealed that the
11 Defendant was a citizen of Mexico, and was not in possession of valid documents allowing him
12 to enter or remain in the United States.

13
14 By questioning the Defendant and through record checks, agents determined that on or
15 about April 22, 2007, the Defendant had been removed from the United States through the port
16 of San Luis, Arizona, subsequent to a conviction in Superior Court, State of California, Ontario
17 County, on or about July 7, 2004, for the crime of Burglary-Second Degree, a felony.

19 Agents determined that on or about February 28, 2007, the Defendant re-entered the
20 United States without the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security having consented
21 to reapplication by the Defendant for admission into the United States.
