Pursuant to and in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 144, the Petitioner respectfully requests a change of Judge due to a bias against petitioner or prejudice either against him or in favor of any adverse party; such judge shall proceed no further therein; but another judge shall be assigned to hear such proceeding - as circumstances exist which would render this 2254 process ineffective to protect the rights of the applicant...


That this averment is made in good faith wherein, petitioner upon information and belief propounds that the factual findings were erroneous and contrary to that which justice and law require.

Petitioner does not believe (after previous, adverse rulings) that Judge Bolton would not have bias against petitioner consistent with repeat denials of any moving paper petitioner files with the Court, after review of earlier proceedings, raises a presumption of inherent prejudice. Thus a constitutional requirement of impartiality, and based on previous "fixed opinions" the interests of justice, the law so requires cannot be protected this render this critical process (sic) ineffective.
