IT IS ORDERED granting Defendant Devon Mitchell's (Defendant) sixth motion to continue the trial and extend time for filing pre-trial motions. (Dkt. 101).

This court specifically finds that the ends of justice served by taking this action outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial. This finding is based on the court's conclusion that the failure to grant such a continuance would unreasonably deny the defendant continuity of counsel and would deny the attorney for defendant the reasonable time necessary for effective preparation, taking into account the exercise of due diligence. 18 U.S.C. §3161(h)(1)(F); (h)(8)(A) and

1 (B)(i)(ii)(iv).

2 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** vacating the June 5, 2007 trial  
3 date, and resetting the matter for September 5, 2007 at 9:00  
4 a.m., in Phoenix, Arizona.

5 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** extending the time for filing  
6 pretrial motions to and including July 23, 2007.

7 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** setting pretrial conferences for  
8 the following dates: June 25, 2007 at 4:00 p.m., July 23,  
9 2007 at 4:00 p.m. and August 27, 2007 at 4:00 p.m.

10 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that excludable time is found to  
11 exist between June 5, 2007 and September 5, 2007 pursuant to  
12 the provisions of 18 U.S.C. §3161 (h)(1)(F); (h)(8)(A) and  
13 (h)(8)(B)(i)(ii)(iv) for a total of 93 days.
