ORDER OF REFERRAL

Defendant MARIO ALBERTO CARMONA-RODRIGUEZ having requested permission to enter a plea of guilty, and having consented to go forward with that plea of guilty before a United States Magistrate Judge, the Court refers the matter to Magistrate Judge EDMONDS to administer the allocation pursuant to Rule 11, F.R.Crim.P., and to make findings as follows:

- (A) whether defendant (1) is competent to enter a plea; (2) knowingly and voluntarily wishes to enter a plea to the charge(s); (3) understands the charge(s); (4) whether there exists a factual basis for the charges; and a recommendation as follows:
- (B) whether the plea of guilty should be accepted by the District Court.
