STATEMENT OF FACTUAL BASIS

The complainant states that this complaint is based upon the statements of the apprehending officers, that the Defendant was found and arrested on or about May 30, 2007, near Yuma, Arizona. Questioning of the Defendant by agents revealed that the Defendant was a citizen of Mexico, and was not in possession of valid documents allowing him to enter or remain in the United States.

By questioning the Defendant and through record checks, agents determined that on or about March 23, 2004, the Defendant had been removed from the United States through the port of Calexico, California, subsequent to a conviction in Superior Court, State of California, Monterey County, on or about September 29, 1993, for the crime of Inflict Corporal Injury to Spouse/Cohab, a felony.

Agents determined that on or about May 1, 2004, the Defendant re-entered the United States without the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security having consented to reapplication by the Defendant for admission into the United States.
