On or about June 1, 2007, in the District of Arizona, within the confines of the Navajo Indian Reservation, Indian Country, the defendant, BRANDEN CHRISTOPHER RICHARDS, did possess, brandish, and discharge a firearm, that is, a 9mm pistol, during and in relation to a

crime of violence against Robert R James, that is, Assault With a Dangerous Weapon and Aggravated Assault, as charged in Count 1, a felony which may be prosecuted in a court of the United States.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1)(A).

COUNT 3

On or about June 1, 2007, in the District of Arizona, within the confines of the Navajo Indian Reservation, Indian Country, the defendant, BRANDEN CHRISTOPHER RICHARDS, a non- Indian, did intentionally assault Christine Thinn, an Indian, with a dangerous weapon, to wit: a firearm, with the intent to do bodily harm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1152 and 113(a)(3).

COUNT 4

On or about June 1, 2007, in the District of Arizona, within the confines of the Navajo Indian Reservation, Indian Country, the defendant, BRANDEN CHRISTOPHER RICHARDS, did possess, brandish, and discharge a firearm, that is, a 9mm pistol, during and in relation to a crime of violence against Christine Thinn, that is, Assault With a Dangerous Weapon and Aggravated Assault, as charged in Count 3, a felony which may be prosecuted in a court of the United States.
