This is the time set for Status Hearing re: 6/5/2007 trial date (1<sup>st</sup> setting).

Defendant orally moves to continue the trial date to allow more time to prepare for trial. The oral motion is granted. (Written order to follow.) The Court specifically finds that the ends of justice served by granting a continuance outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial. This finding is based upon the Court's conclusion that the failure to grant such a continuance would deny the defendant the reasonable time necessary for effective preparation, taking into account the exercise of due diligence. 18 U.S.C. §3161(h)(8)(B)(iv).

Trial is reset to: **August 7, 2007 at 9:00 a.m.**
