

 WAIVER OF INDICTMENT

The government is pursuing the charges against you through a document called an Information. An Information is an informal means of prosecuting offenses against the laws of the United States. If you wanted, you could require the government to obtain an Indictment to pursue these charges. If you requested that, the government would have to go before a Grand Jury (made up of between 16 and 23 U.S. citizens) and convince at least 12 of those grand jurors that there is a reasonable basis to conclude that you committed the offense before an Indictment would issue.

Are you willing to give up your right to require an Indictment and proceed instead by way of an Information?
