) **ORDER**

On September 23, 2009, Plaintiff Anthony Grady, who is confined in the Maricopa County Lower Buckeye Jail, filed a *pro se* civil rights Complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 and an Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis*. In a November 2, 2009 Order, the Court granted the Application to Proceed, but dismissed the Complaint, with leave to amend, because Plaintiff had failed to state a claim upon which relief could be granted. The Court gave Plaintiff 30 days to file an amended complaint that cured the deficiencies identified in the Order.

On November 10, 2009, Plaintiff filed a First Amended Complaint (Doc. #5).

**I. First Amended Complaint is not signed**

All pleadings must be signed by the party if the party is not represented by an attorney. Fed. R. Civ. P. 11(a) and LRCiv 3.4(a), 7.1(b)(1). An unsigned pleading must be stricken unless omission of the signature is corrected promptly after being called to the attention of the party. Fed. R. Civ. P. 11(a).

1 Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint is unsigned. Therefore, Plaintiff will be  
2 permitted 30 days from the filing date of this Order to submit a completed and signed  
3 Certificate, using the Certificate form included with this Order, certifying that Plaintiff's  
4 signature on the Certificate shall serve as an original signature on his First Amended  
5 Complaint for the purposes of Rule 3.4(a) of the Local Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 11  
6 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

## 7 **II. Warnings**

### 8 **A. Release**

9 Plaintiff must pay the unpaid balance of the filing fee within 120 days of his release.  
10 Also, within 30 days of his release, he must either (1) notify the Court that he intends to pay  
11 the balance or (2) show good cause, in writing, why he cannot. Failure to comply may result  
12 in dismissal of this action.

### 13 **B. Address Changes**

14 Plaintiff must file and serve a notice of a change of address in accordance with Rule  
15 83.3(d) of the Local Rules of Civil Procedure. Plaintiff must not include a motion for other  
16 relief with a notice of change of address. Failure to comply may result in dismissal of this  
17 action.

### 18 **C. Copies**

19 Plaintiff must submit an additional copy of every filing for use by the Court. See  
20 LRCiv 5.4. Failure to comply may result in the filing being stricken without further notice  
21 to Plaintiff.

### 22 **D. Possible "Strike"**

23 Because the Complaint was dismissed for failure to state a claim, if Plaintiff fails to  
24 submit a completed and signed Certificate, the First Amended Complaint will be stricken and  
25 the dismissal of the original Complaint may count as a "strike" under the "3-strikes"  
26 provision of 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g). Under the 3-strikes provision, a prisoner may not bring  
27 a civil action or appeal a civil judgment *in forma pauperis* under 28 U.S.C. § 1915 "if the  
28 prisoner has, on 3 or more prior occasions, while incarcerated or detained in any facility,

1 brought an action or appeal in a court of the United States that was dismissed on the grounds  
2 that it is frivolous, malicious, or fails to state a claim upon which relief may be granted,  
3 unless the prisoner is under imminent danger of serious physical injury.” 28 U.S.C.  
4 § 1915(g).

5 **E. Possible Dismissal**

6 If Plaintiff fails to timely comply with every provision of this Order, including these  
7 warnings, the Court may dismiss this action without further notice. Ferdik v. Bonzelet, 963  
8 F.2d 1258, 1260-61 (9th Cir. 1992) (a district court may dismiss an action for failure to  
9 comply with any order of the Court).

10 **IT IS ORDERED:**


11 (1) Within 30 days of the date this Order is filed, Plaintiff must file a completed  
12 and signed Certificate, using the Certificate form provided with this Order, certifying that  
13 Plaintiff’s signature on the Certificate shall serve as an original signature on his First  
14 Amended Complaint for the purposes Rule 3.4(a) of the Local Rules of Civil Procedure and  
15 Rule 11 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

16 (2) If Plaintiff fails to file, within 30 days, a completed and signed Certificate on  
17 the form provided with this Order, the Clerk of Court must strike Plaintiff’s First Amended  
18 Complaint and enter a judgment of dismissal of this action with prejudice that states that the  
19 dismissal may count as a “strike” under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g).

20 (3) The Clerk of Court must mail Plaintiff a Certificate form.
