David Torrez and four other inmates confined in the La Palma Corrections Center (LPCC), a Corrections Corporation of America (CCA) facility in Eloy, Arizona, filed a joint *pro se* Civil Rights Complaint by a Prisoner under 28 U.S.C. § 1983, Torrez v. Corrections Corp. of America, No. CV09-2298-PHX-MHM (MHB), doc.# 1.<sup>1</sup> Torrez (Plaintiff) filed a First Amended Complaint. (Doc.# 8.) In an Order filed May 20, 2010, the Court dismissed the First Amended Complaint with leave to file a second amended complaint within 30 days. (Doc.# 18.) Plaintiff has filed a motion for an extension of time until July 17, 2010. (Doc.# 22.) Plaintiff’s motion will be granted.

**Warnings**

**A. Release**

Plaintiff must pay the unpaid balance of the filing fee within 120 days of his release. Also, within days of his release, he must either (1) notify the Court that he intends to pay the balance or (2) show good cause, in writing, why he cannot. Failure to comply may result in

1 dismissal of this action.

2 **B. Address Changes**

3 Plaintiff must file and serve a notice of a change of address in accordance with Rule  
4 83.3(d) of the Local Rules of Civil Procedure. Plaintiff must not include a motion for other  
5 relief with a notice of change of address. Failure to comply may result in dismissal of this  
6 action.

7 **C. Copies**

8 Plaintiff must submit an additional copy of every filing for use by the Court. See  
9 LRCiv 5.4. Failure to comply may result in the filing being stricken without further notice  
10 to Plaintiff.

11 **D. Possible Dismissal**


12 If Plaintiff fails to timely comply with every provision of this Order, including these  
13 warnings, the Court may dismiss this action without further notice. See Ferdik, 963 F.2d at  
14 1260-61 (a district court may dismiss an action for failure to comply with any order of the  
15 Court).

16 **IT IS ORDERED:**

17 (1) Plaintiff's motion for an extension of time until **July 17, 2010** in which to file  
18 a second amended complaint in compliance with the Court's May 20, 2010 Order, doc.# 18,  
19 is **granted**. (Doc.# 22.)

20 (2) If Plaintiff fails to file an amended complaint by **July 17, 2010**, the Clerk of  
21 Court must, without further notice, enter a judgment of dismissal of this action with  
22 prejudice.
