The court has before it the parties' "Stipulation for Voluntary Dismissal With Prejudice as to Plaintiff Lois Hobbs" (doc. 1125). Pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), Fed. R. Civ. P., plaintiff may dismiss an action by filing a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared. Further, the parties may stipulate that the dismissal be with prejudice. Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(B).

Therefore, **IT IS ORDERED GRANTING** the parties' stipulation for dismissal (doc. 1125). **IT IS ORDERED** that the complaint is dismissed with prejudice as to plaintiff Lois Hobbs, each party to bear its own costs and attorneys' fees.
