15	Pending before the court is the Report and Recommendation ("R&R") of Magistrate	
16	Judge Aspey (doc. 9) regarding Plaintiff's Amended Complaint (doc. 7). The R&R	
17	recommends that the action be dismissed without prejudice for failure of service of process.	
18	No objections were filed.	
19	Because the parties did not file objections, the court need not review any of the	
20	Magistrate Judge's determinations on dispositive matters. See 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1);	
21	Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b); United States v. Reyna-Tapia, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9th Cir. 2003);	
22	Thomas v. Arn, 474 U.S. 140, 149 (1985) ("[Section 636(b)(1)] does not require any	
23	review at all of any issue that is not the subject of an objection.").	
24	Notwithstanding the absence of an objection, the court has reviewed the R&R and	
25	finds that it is well taken. The court will accept the R&R and dismiss the action. See 28	
26	U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) (stating that the district court "may accept, reject, or modify, in whole or	
27	in part, the findings or recommendations made by the magistrate").	
28	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Report and Recommendation of the Magistrate	

1	Judge (doc. #9) is accepted.
2	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court enter judgment dismissing
3	this action without prejudice. The Clerk shall terminate this action.
