17	The Ninth Circuit has issued its mandate in this case, remanding this matter to the	
18	Department of the Interior for reconsideration in light of the Ninth Circuit's opinion.	
19	Doc. 165. The Court of Appeals has provided no guidance on the role of this Court with	
20	respect to the remand. This Court in other cases has entered an order remanding the	
21	matter to the federal agency and setting a date by which the agency shall complete its	
22	consideration on remand. The Court has required the new agency decision to be filed by	
23	the deadline, and has required the opposing party to indicate, within 30 days of the new	
24	decision being issued, whether it continues to contest the agency action, in which event a	
25	scheduling conference is held to address briefing with respect to alleged flaws in the new	
26	decision. On or before July 31, 2013 the parties shall file a joint memorandum setting	
27	forth their position on whether such an order should be entered in this case, and, if so,	
28	what time periods should be included, or whe	ther the Court should take some other action
