Doc. 7. 20 Plaintiff has not filed an affidavit of service or otherwise shown that it served the motion 21 on Defendants as required by Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 5(a). See Doc. 7. 22 Accordingly, the motion will be denied without prejudice. 23 IT IS ORDERED: 24 This matter will be dismissed 14 days from the date of this Order if Plaintiff 25 fails to show good cause before that date for its failure to serve the summons and 26 complaint. 27 2. Directing the Clerk of the Court to terminate this matter on 28

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March 18, 2011 without further leave of this Court if Plaintiff fails to respond to this Order within the time stated.

3. Plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction (Doc. 7) is **denied**. Dated this 4th day of March, 2011.
