18 Presently before the court is a motion for a settlement
19 conference by defendants Bravo, Hetrick, McWilliams, Reagan,
20 and Ryan ("the State defendants") (Doc. 156). The plaintiff
21 "does not oppose setting a settlement conference and is
22 willing to participate in good faith." Resp. (Doc. 163) at
23 3:1-2. The other defendant Darren Webster, who is
24 represented by separate counsel, did not join in the State
25 defendants' motion or otherwise respond in any way to that
26 motion. And, the time to do so has passed. Thus, in
27 accordance with LRCiv 7.2(i), defendant Webster is deemed to
28 have consented to the granting of the State defendants'

1 motion for a settlement conference.

2 Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that a settlement
3 conference shall be held before United States Magistrate Judge
4 James F. Metcalf.
