) **ORDER**

16 The court has before it petitioner’s amended motion to vacate, set aside or correct
17 sentence by a person in federal custody pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255 (doc. 4), respondent’s
18 response (doc. 6), and the report and recommendation of the United States Magistrate Judge
