**ORDER**

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15 Plaintiff Miriam Mendiola-Martinez commenced this action against Defendants  
16 Joseph Arpaio and Maricopa County and others in December 2011, asserting five claims:  
17 (1) deliberate indifference to her serious medical needs in violation of the Eighth  
18 Amendment; (2) deliberate indifference to her serious medical needs in violation of the  
19 Fourteenth Amendment; (3) cruel and unusual punishment in violation of the Eighth and  
20 Fourteenth Amendments; (4) disparate treatment in violation of the Fifth, Fourteenth, and  
21 Fifteenth Amendments; and (5) *Monell* liability. See Doc. 1. The Court granted  
22 summary judgment in favor of Defendants on all counts on January 22, 2014. Doc. 121.

23 Defendants have now filed a motion for attorneys' fees pursuant to 42 U.S.C.  
24 § 1988(b). Doc. 137. The motion is fully briefed. Docs. 144, 149. Plaintiff filed a  
25 notice of appeal to the Ninth Circuit on January 31, 2014 (Doc. 122) and filed amended  
26 notices on March 10, 2014 (Doc. 132), and April 22, 2014 (Doc. 146).

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
