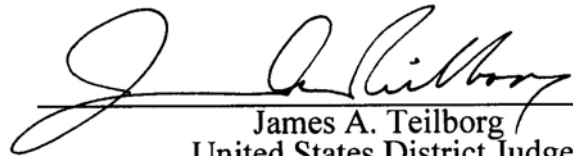
ORDER

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16 “Inquiring whether the court has jurisdiction is a federal judge’s first duty in every
17 case.” *Belleville Catering Co. v. Champaign Market Place, L.L.C.*, 350 F.3d 691, 693 (7th
18 Cir. 2003). In this case, the complaint fails to sufficiently plead jurisdiction. *See* 28 U.S.C.
19 § 1332; *Johnson v. Columbia Properties Anchorage, L.P.*, 437 F.3d 894, 899 (9th Cir. 2006)
20 (discussing the citizenship of a limited liability company).

21 Accordingly,

22 **IT IS ORDERED** that by August 24, 2012, Plaintiff shall file a supplement to the
23 complaint properly alleging federal subject matter jurisdiction, or this case will be dismissed
24 without prejudice for lack of federal subject matter jurisdiction.
