

¹ On June 8, 1993, Petitioner was convicted of two counts of attempted first-degree murder and received aggravated sentences of 28 years on each count. The convictions became final on November 24, 1994. The Anti-Terrorism and Effective Death Penalty Act ("AEDPA") went into effect April 24, 1996. Petitioner filed his habeas petition on August 1, 2012. Magistrate Judge Bade recommended that the petition be denied as untimely, having been filed 15 years after the expiration AEDPA's one-year statute of limitations.
