15	5 Pending before the Court is Magistrate	Judge Metcalf's Report and
16	Recommendation on Stay of Petition ("R&R") (Doc. 59). Therein, Judge Metcalf	
17	recommends that consideration of Petitioner's Amended Petition for Writ of Habeas	
18	Corpus be stayed until completion of Petitioner's pending proceedings before the Arizona	
19	Supreme Court. (<i>Id.</i> at 10–11). Judge Metcalf advised the parties that they had fourteen	
20	days to file objections and that the failure to timely do so "will be considered a waiver of	
21	a party's right to <i>de novo</i> consideration of the issues." (<i>Id.</i> at 11) (citing <i>United States v.</i>	
22	2 Reyna-Tapia, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9th Cir. 2003) (et	n banc)). Neither party has filed
23	3 objections to the R&R. The Court has nonether	ess reviewed the findings and
24	4 recommendations made therein and finds no reas	son to disagree or modify its
25	recommendations. The Court will, therefore, accept the R&R and stay this matter pending	
26	Petitioner's state court proceedings. See 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) ("A judge of the court may	
27	accept, reject, or modify, in whole or in part, the findings or recommendations made by the	
28	8 magistrate judge."); Fed.R.Civ.P. 72(b)(3) (same).

2	Accordingly,	
3	IT IS ORDERED that Magistrate Judge Metcalf's Report and Recommendation	
4	(Doc. 59) is ACCEPTED and ADOPTED as the Order of this Court.	
5	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that consideration of Petitioner's Amended Petition	
6	for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Doc. 11) is STAYED until completion of Petitioner's pending	
7	proceedings before the Arizona Supreme Court.	
8	IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that Petitioner shall be required to file a Notice of	
9	Status of his state court proceedings within 30 days of this Order, every three (3) months	
10	thereafter, and within 30 days of any final ruling by the Arizona Supreme Court in such	
11	proceeding.
