15	On March 8, 2018, the Court issued an Order (Doc. 24) granting in part and
16	denying in part Defendants' Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 14). Thirty days later, on April 9,
17	2018, Plaintiffs move for reconsideration of that Order. (Doc. 27).
18	Local Rule of Civil Procedure 7.2(g)(2) provides that "[a]bsent good cause
19	shown, any motion for reconsideration shall be filed not later than fourteen (14) days
20	after the date of the filing of the Order that is the subject of the motion." The
21	Court does not find that Plaintiffs have shown good cause for filing the Motion for
22	Reconsideration (Doc. 27) more than fourteen days after the Court issued its Order (Doc.
23	24). The Motion (Doc. 27) therefore will be denied as untimely. Moreover, the Court
24	notes that Plaintiff has timely filed a Second Amended Complaint (Doc. 26) reasserting
25	the claims dismissed without prejudice in the Court's Order (Doc. 24).
26	Accordingly,
27	IT IS ORDERED denying Plaintiffs' Motion for Reconsideration (Doc. 27).
