15 Defendant/Movant Adrian Perez-Sanchez has filed a motion to vacate sentence
16 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255. Doc. 1. United States Magistrate Judge Eileen S. Willett
17 has issued a report and recommendation (“R&R”) recommending that the motion be
18 denied. Doc. 9. No objection has been filed, which relieves the Court of its obligation to
19 review the R&R. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1); Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b)(3); *Thomas v. Arn*,
20 474 U.S. 140, 149 (1985); *United States v. Reyna-Tapia*, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9th Cir.
21 2003). The Court will accept the R&R and deny the motion.
