14	Plaintiff, Michael Aaron Turner, filed a complaint, first amended complaint, and		
15	second amended complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (Docs. 1, 5, 8) and motion for		
16	leave to proceed in this matter in forma pauperis on December 15, 2017 (Doc. 2).		
17	Plaintiff was released from custody at some point prior to December 11, 2018. On		
18	February 21, 2019, noting that Plaintiff had been released from custody, the Court		
19	ordered Plaintiff to either pay the \$350.00 filing fee or file a non-prisoner application to		
20	proceed in District Court without prepaying fees or costs. Doc. 17. Plaintiff was warned		
21	that his failure to comply with the Order would result in this case being dismissed. <i>Id</i> .		
22	The Magistrate Judge granted Plaintiff an additional extension of time to comply		
23	with the Court's Order (Doc. 17) and allowed Plaintiff until April 25, 2019 to either pay		
24	the \$350.00 filing fee or file a non-prisoner application to proceed in District Curt		
25	without prepaying fees or costs. Doc. 21. Plaintiff was again warned that his failure to		
26	comply with the Court's Orders (Docs. 17, 21) would result in the dismissal of this case.		
27	Plaintiff has failed to comply with the Court's orders.		
28	United States Magistrate Judge Car	nille D. Bibles has issued a report and	

1	recommend	ation (" $R \& R$ ") recommending that the second amended complaint be	
2	recommendation ("R&R") recommending that the second amended complaint be dismissed without prejudice for Plaintiff's failure to comply with the Court's orders.		
2	Doc. 22. No objection has been filed, which relieves the Court of its obligation to review		
4	the R&R. See 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1); Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b)(3); Thomas v. Arn, 474 U.S.		
5	140, 149 (1985); United States v. Reyna-Tapia, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9th Cir. 2003). The		
6	Court will accept the R&R and dismiss Plaintiff's second amended complaint without		
7	prejudice.		
8	IT IS ORDERED:		
9	1.	The R&R (Doc. 22) is accepted.	
10	2.	Plaintiff's second amended complaint filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983	
11		(Docs. 8) is dismissed without prejudice.	
12	3.	A certificate of appealability and leave to proceed in forma pauperis on	
13		appeal are denied	
14	4.	The Clerk is directed to terminate this action.
