15 Pending before the Court is a mandate from the Ninth Circuit, informing the Court  
16 of the Ninth’s Circuit’s reversal and remand of this Court’s order and the ALJ’s decision  
17 in this case. (Doc. 39; 39-1.)

18 The Ninth Circuit’s Memorandum Opinion remands this matter to the agency for  
19 further proceedings. (Doc. 39-1 at 7.) The Ninth Circuit directs the agency “to reevaluate  
20 the record—and, specifically, to consider evidence regarding mental impairments and  
21 symptoms—to determine whether Johnson is disabled” as “rapidly as possible on remand.”  
22 (*Id.*)

23 Accordingly,

24 **IT IS ORDERED** remanding this case for further proceedings consistent with the  
25 Ninth Circuit’s Memorandum Opinion. (Doc. 39-1.)
