(Doc. 6 at 1.) Prudential plans to attempt service 16 of process on Dylan by sending a process server to the State Hospital. (Doc. 6 at 2.) Without 17 addressing whether that service will be proper, Prudential may attempt such service. 18 Prudential states it "named Joyce Houser as a defendant . . . in her sole capacity as 19 guardian of minor J.D." (Doc. 6 at 2.) Despite that, Prudential then states it has "named 20 both Joyce Houser and J.D. as defendants." (Doc. 6 at 2.) Given that she is not being named 21 in any capacity other than as guardian of J.D., Joyce Houser will not be listed as a separate 22 defendant. 23 24 25 26 27 28

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED Prudential shall submit, and the Clerk of Court shall issue, new summons in the names of 1) Dylan Houser; and 2) Joyce Houser, solely in her capacity as guardian of J.D.
