In an order (Doc. 5) entered on July 27, 2010, the Court summarily dismissed the plaintiff's complaint without prejudice for failure to state a claim for relief that complied with the <u>Twombly/Iqbal</u> pleading standard; the Court further required the plaintiff the file an amended complaint properly stating a claim for relief no later than August 6, 2010. IT IS ORDERED that the plaintiff shall show cause in writing no later than **August 30, 2010** why the Court should not dismiss this action pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 41(b) due to her failure to obey the Court's order of July 27, 2010.<sup>1</sup>

The plaintiff is advised that her failure to timely comply with this order shall result in the dismissal of this action without prejudice.
