**ORDER**

On August 1, 2012, Petitioner Edward F. Parks, who is confined in the Arizona State Prison Complex-Yuma in San Luis, Arizona, filed a *pro se* Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 and an Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* (Doc. 2).

**I. Failure to Pay Filing Fee**

Section 1914(a), 28 U.S.C., establishes a \$5.00 filing fee for applications for a writ of habeas corpus. Rule 3.5(b) of the Local Rules of Civil Procedure requires that “[i]f a habeas corpus petitioner desires to prosecute the petition *in forma pauperis*, the petitioner shall file an application to proceed *in forma pauperis* on a form approved by the Court, accompanied by a certification of the warden or other appropriate officer of the institution in which the petitioner is confined as to the amount of money or securities on deposit to the petitioner’s credit.” Rule 3.5(b) also requires payment of the \$5.00 filing fee if a petitioner has in excess of \$25.00 in his inmate account.

1           Although Petitioner has used the court-approved form, the “Certificate of Correctional  
2 Official as to Status of Applicant’s Trust Account” section has not been completed by an  
3 authorized correctional official, as required. In light of this discrepancy, the Court will deny  
4 the Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* and will give Petitioner 30 days to either pay  
5 the \$5.00 filing fee or submit a complete Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis*.

6 **II. Warnings**

7 **A. Address Changes**

8           Petitioner must file and serve a notice of a change of address in accordance with Rule  
9 83.3(d) of the Local Rules of Civil Procedure. Petitioner must not include a motion for other  
10 relief with a notice of change of address. Failure to comply may result in dismissal of this  
11 action.

12 **B. Copies**

13           Petitioner must submit an additional copy of every filing for use by the Court. See  
14 LRCiv 5.4. Failure to comply may result in the filing being stricken without further notice  
15 to Petitioner.

16 **C. Possible Dismissal**

17           If Petitioner fails to timely comply with every provision of this Order, including these  
18 warnings, the Court may dismiss this action without further notice. See *Ferdik v. Bonzelet*,  
19 963 F.2d 1258, 1260-61 (9th Cir. 1992) (a district court may dismiss an action for failure to  
20 comply with any order of the Court).

21 **IT IS ORDERED:**

22           (1) Petitioner’s Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* (Doc. 2) is **denied**  
23 **without prejudice**.

24           (2) Within 30 days of the date this Order is filed, Petitioner must either pay the  
25 \$5.00 filing fee **or** file a complete Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis*.


26           (3) If Petitioner fails to either pay the \$5.00 filing fee or file a complete  
27 Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* within 30 days, the Clerk of Court must enter a  
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1 judgment of dismissal of this action without prejudice and without further notice to  
2 Petitioner.

3 (4) The Clerk of Court must mail Petitioner a court-approved form for filing an  
4 Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* (Habeas).
