**ORDER**

On November 4, 2009, Magistrate Judge Bernardo P. Velasco issued a Report and Recommendation [Doc. # 12] in which he recommended that this Court remand the case pursuant to sentence six of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), for the purpose of consideration of the new evidence. Alternatively, the Magistrate Judge recommended that this Court remand the case for further findings consistent with the Report.
