
Magistrate Judge Velasco filed his Report and Recommendation on September 1, 2009, recommending that the District Court dismiss the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241 and dismiss the action with prejudice. A copy was sent to all parties on September 1, 2009, notifying all parties that written objections must be filed within ten days of service. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b).
