ORDER

Pending before the Court is a Report and Recommendation issued by United States Magistrate Judge D. Thomas Ferraro that recommends granting Respondent’s Motion to Dismiss and denying Petitioner’s habeas petition filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2241. (Doc. 21.) As thoroughly explained by Magistrate Judge Ferraro, Petitioner is not entitled to relief as he failed to exhaust his administrative remedies prior to filing his Petition. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:


(1) The Report and Recommendation (Doc. 21) is accepted and adopted;
