**ORDER**

Pending before the Court is a Report and Recommendation issued by United States Magistrate Judge D. Leslie A. Bowman that recommends dismissing Petitioner’s habeas petition filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2241. (Doc. 24.) As thoroughly explained by Magistrate Judge Bowman, Petitioner is not entitled to relief because he failed to exhaust his administrative remedies prior to filing his Petition and because his Petition is without merit.
