
ORDER

On July 30, 2018, this Court gave the Plaintiff, who proceeds pro se in this action, notice that a Motion to Dismiss for lack of jurisdiction had been filed by Defendant and he had failed to file a Response. The Court ordered the Plaintiff to show cause in writing why the case should not be dismissed with prejudice for failing to follow the directives of the Court and file a Response.
