<u>ORDER</u>

By Order dated December 12, 2008 (DE #3), this Court granted plaintiff's application to

service is appropriate with respect to defendants Young, Sheppard and Dowill. Accordingly,

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that service is appropriate for the defendants Tony Younger,

Sgt. Sheppard and Rhonda Dowell. The Clerk of the Court shall prepare summons for the defendants

and the United States Marshal is hereby directed to serve a copy of the original (DE #2) and amended

complaints (DE #5) and summons on defendants without prepayment of fees and costs or security

therefore.
