<u>ORDER</u>

By Order dated June 5, 2009 (DE #5), this Court granted plaintiff's application to proceed <u>in forma</u> <u>pauperis</u> in this action filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Box 20550, Pine Bluff, AR 71612-0550, without prepayment of fees and costs or security therefore.
