<sup>1</sup>Plaintiff filed her objections more than fourteen days after entry of the proposed findings and recommended disposition. However, the Arkansas Department of Correction (ADC) notified the Court, by letter dated August 24, 2012 (docket entry #29), that the objections would have been received by the Clerk's Office on August 17, 2012 but for an inadvertent error on the part of ADC mail room staff. The Court has reviewed Plaintiff's objections.

1. Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment (docket entry #20) is GRANTED, and this case is DISMISSED, WITHOUT PREJUDICE.

2. The Court CERTIFIES, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3), that an *in forma pauperis* appeal would not be taken in good faith.
