**JUDGMENT**

This matter came before the Court for a jury trial on the 27th day of August, 2013. Both parties announced ready for trial. A jury of twelve was selected and duly sworn. At the conclusion of all of the evidence, and after the jury had been instructed on the law, the jury returned a verdict as follows:


