**ORDER** 

The Court has received two Proposed Findings and Recommendations

("Recommendation") from Magistrate Judge Jerome T. Kearney (Dkt. Nos. 13; 39). Plaintiff

Chanda L. Hill filed timely objections to the first Recommendation (Dkt. No. 25). After

carefully considering the first Recommendation and Ms. Hill's objections, and after making a de

novo review of the record in this case, the Court concludes that the first Recommendation should

be, and hereby is, approved and adopted as this Court's findings in all respects (Dkt. No. 13).

Therefore, the Court dismisses Ms. Hill's claims against defendants Banks, Culclager,

considering the second Recommendation, the Court adopts it in its entirety. Accordingly, all of

the remaining claims in Ms. Hill's complaint are dismissed without prejudice for failure to

prosecute. All other pending motions are denied as moot.
