ORDER

On *de novo* review, the Court adopts the recommendation, N_2 3, and overrules Locke's partial objections, N_2 6. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b)(3). If Locke wants to allege additional facts against Williams, then he must do so in a motion to amend his complaint, not in his objections to the recommendation. Locke's claims against Williams, Johnson, and Day are dismissed without prejudice. His claims against the Arkansas Department of Correction are dismissed with prejudice.
